The sector: Higher education and research


Australia's higher education and research sector comprises 42 universities, 60 medical research institutions and ten publiclyfunded research organisations across Australia.

Together they employ almost 300,000 people, and bring in an annual revenue of over \$37.8 billion.

SAGE supports a vast majority of this sector. Our participating institutions account for 85% of all university employees and 76% of publicly-funded research agency employees.

With our support, 42 organisations of various sizes and sectors have successfully achieved SAGE accreditation.

In total, our subscribers employ ~210,640 people around Australia.

Be an 'Equity Supporter': Add on to your package

Improving conference inclusion for people from marginalised groups is essential. As the people most affected by barriers to inclusion, they are often also the ones who do most of the EDI work.

Many people may need different kinds of supports to attend and contribute.

Improving conference inclusion for people from marginalised groups is essential. As the people most affected by barriers to inclusion, they are often also the ones who do most of the EDI work.

For these groups, your support as a sponsor will directly increase participation, offering you great visibility and a reputational boost as **an organisation that "walks the talk".**

We will ask applicants to self-identify the amount and type of support they need. This eliminates restrictive criteria and ensures delegates are supported in a way that suits their circumstances. We aim to support as many bursary applicants as possible.

Support accessibility: Ensure people with disability are able to participate fully and safely.

- ✓ Live captioning (and sign language, if requested) services
- √ Support to bring a carer or interpreter (subsidised travel and accommodation)

Support equal participation: Subsidise those for whom conference costs are prohibitive.

- ✓ Registration
- √ Travel and accommodation

Support parents and carers: Ensure those with dependents are able to attend with peace of mind.

- ✓ On-site or nearby childcare facilities
- ✓ Parenting room
- Childcare or other care arrangements, for example bringing a family member to perform caring duties or to organise for someone to care for dependants back home

Any other needs, as identified by applicants.



Environmental and social consciousness

You'll be pleased to know that your contribution will be used in an environmentally and socially responsible way.

To reduce our collective carbon footprint, we are minimising the amount of collateral, for example by using digital programs only, and asking participants to bring their own stationery.

Where possible, procurement will be from social enterprises and Indigenous-owned organisations.
